Marco is a founding member of the team leading the Firm's efforts to prosecute securities claims related to public offerings in state courts following the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in *Cyan, Inc. v. Beaver County Employees Retirement Fund*. Marco has also successfully represented dissenting shareholders in a foreign appraisal action in the Cayman Islands, securing a favorable judgment on behalf of his clients following a three-week bench trial. Skilled in all phases of litigation including pleadings, dispositive motions, discovery, trial, and appeal, Marco develops innovative, fact-based case theories to expose violations of the securities laws and recover clients' financial losses.

Marco has played a key role prosecuting and resolving several high-profile cases, such as those against Nord Anglia Education, Inc. (\$37.68 per share fair value appraisal—a 16% premium over the take-private transaction price); Spectrum Brands Holdings, Inc. (\$9 million settlement); and Livent Corporation (\$7.4 million settlement).

Prior to joining Labaton Sucharow, Marco was a Paralegal at Harras Bloom & Archer LLP, where he focused on real estate litigation in state and federal courts, land use and zoning, and real estate transactions. During law school, Marco was a Summer Associate at Linklaters LLP, where he focused on cross-border mergers and acquisitions (M&A) governed by U.S. law.

Marco is an active member of the New York City Bar Association and the New York State Bar Association.

Marco earned his Juris Doctor, *cum laude*, from Brooklyn Law School, where he served as Associate Managing Editor and Senior Staff of the Brooklyn Journal of International Law.
